# Wyoming Airport Grants

U.S. Transportation Secretary Elaine L. Chao Announces \$2.1 million in Infrastructure Grants to Five Airports in Wyoming

**\$600,000 to Converse County Airport in Douglas** to repair runway lighting and to install navigational aids and a runway vertical/visual guidance system.

**\$522,000 to Torrington Municipal Airport** for runway repairs.



**\$429,129 to the Johnson County Airport in Buffalo** to purchase snow-removal equipment.

**\$350,000 to the Dixon Airport** for runway repairs.

**\$250,000 to Powell Municipal Airport** to build a taxiway.
